

YOUNG VOLUNTEER'S PROGRAMME
2018/19

The West Midlands Young Volunteer's Programme is open to any Swim England club member from within the West Midlands aged 14 – 16 years on day of course.

There are a total of 64 places available on the programme, places will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Once all places are filled your name will be added to a waiting list, and notified is a place becomes available. We are running the programme out of two venues this year, you can choose to either attend at the Royal Life Saving Society in Worcester or The Snow Dome in Tamworth.

The cost per young volunteer is £25, payable by BACS transfer or cheque following confirmation of your place on the programme.

The project will give you the skills, experience and qualification to help volunteer at your club. Volunteering is a really great way of giving something back to your club, but it also gives you valuable life skills in preparation for adulthood.

This year's courses will include:

- **First Steps into Coaching** – This course is designed to help you understand the different roles within coaching. It covers the knowledge, skills and qualities that are required to take your first steps into coaching.
- **Timekeeper Course** - This is an introduction into the world of the swimming official. It covers the practical aspects of what is required of a timekeeper by means of a short theory session followed by a practical assessment.
- **Aquatic Helper Course** – This course is designed for people who wish to actively assist on poolside in any aquatic environment e.g. clubs or learn to swim schemes.
- **Life Support Course** – Life Support covers the basics of how to perform CPR, including the diagnosis and treatment for Choking, Bleeding and Shock on an Adult Casualty.
